HISTORIC LIVINGSTON

ivingston has always been an important part of connecting the west. In 1806, Captain William Clark, Sacajewea, and other members of the Corps of Discovery camped here while following the Yellowstone River. Eighty years later, the Northern Pacific Railway chose the area as an important stop along the route, and named the town after its director Johnston Livingston. The railroad gave life to the town until the 1980s, and since then Livingston continues to connect people with the western spirit through tourism, the arts, and providing a spectacular place to live.

- Historic legend Calamity Jane called Livingston home for several decades in the late 1800s.
- In 1938, Dan Bailey started his legendary flyfishing business, and it is still a destination for anglers today.
- In 2016, Livingston was named Montana's Outstanding Film Community.
- Livingston was 2017's Montana Office Of Tourism and Business Development's Community of the Year.
